(Single App License)

Backend download

Get the Backend from here <https://content.mintsoft.org/activate.php>

- 1) Enter your Codecanyon purchase code to verify your purchase.
- 2) Put your valid email address where download link will be delivered.
- 3) Enter the website name where you will run the backend. Sub-domain (*https://subdomain.yourdomain.tld*) also allowed but you cannot enter sub directory of a domain. Make sure you use SSL certificate for your website. Because starting from "Android version 9 (Pie)" SSL is mandatory.
- 4) Enter your android app package name. For more information about package name visit <https://developer.android.com/studio/build/application-id>
- 5) Make sure you entered the information correctly. Information cannot be changed once you click on "Submit And Download Backend" button

Installation

- * Copy all the files and folders from **upload** directory to your web hosting base directory.
- * Create a MySQL user and database.
- * Visit your domain / subdomain for backend installation.

- 1) Enter your backend name.
- 2) Enter your backend URL (usually it automatically detects).
- 3) Enter MySQL database hostname (most of the time it's either 127.0.0.1 or localhost)
- 4) Enter MySQL your database port (default port is 3306)
- 5) Enter your database name.
- 6) Enter your database username.
- 7) Enter your database user's password.
- 8) If these shown lines are green that means you are ready to go. Otherwise follow those red instructions to fix them.

If everything is okay you will be able to **Install the backend**.

Now access the backend by going to: ***https://your-domain.tld/login***
